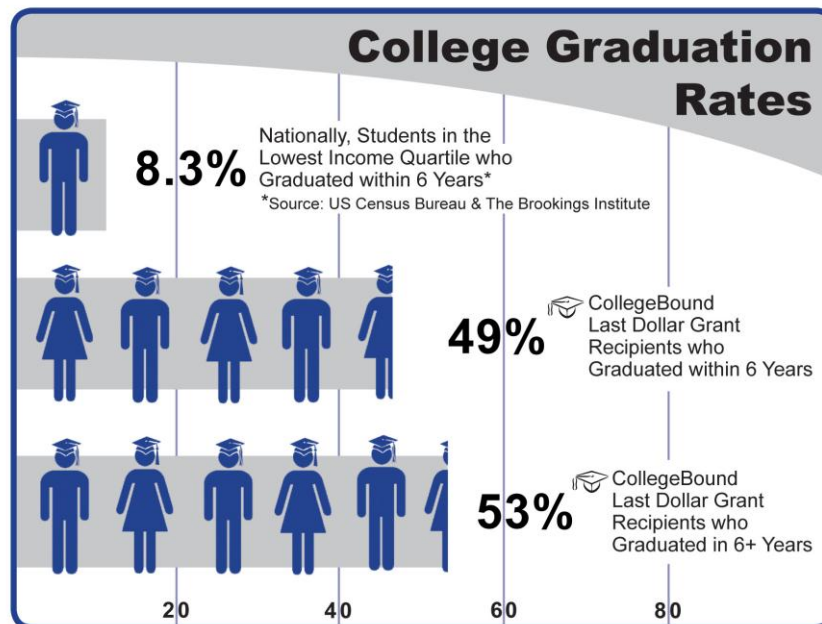
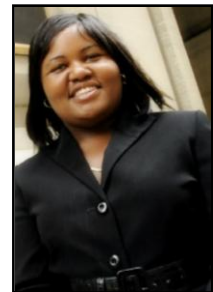
CollegeBound has the law on its side.

They created the Annual Lawyers' Campaign for CollegeBound Foundation and set the crucial foundation for the Campaign as it stands today.
